Before signing in to Typing Pal, be sure your child is signed in to his or her Park Tudor Google account by following the instructions for "Using Google Apps @ Home". If signing in to Typing Pal does not follow the instructions listed here, that means Google is signed in to someone else's account.

All students, 3rd-5th grade, can use their Park Tudor Google account to access Typing Pal online.

Typing Pal will use your child's Park Tudor Google account to "Allow" access. If Typing Pal asks you if you already have an account, that indicates Google is signed into someone else's account. Follow Step 1 for Using Google Apps @ Home.

4 SIMPLE STEPS FOR

USING GOOGLE APPS @ HOME

Park Tudor's 3rd-5th graders have a school Google account that gives them access to Google Apps like Drive, Classroom, and Docs. Typing Pal, too!

To sign in to a Park Tudor Google account, follow these steps:



WWW.GOOGLE.COM

Click the Sign In button. If you see a circle with a letter in it, or a picture, it means someone is already signed in to a Google account. Just sign out.





The full email address will end with "@parktudor.org".

3 ENTER THE PASSWORD

Students are assigned (depending on age) passwords and they are encouraged to always share their passwords, on all accounts, with a parent.



4 CHOOSE THE GOOGLE APP YOU'D LIKE TO USE.

By clicking on the nine gray dots in the upper right corner, you'll see the Google Apps available to students. Gmail will not appear. To see more, click "More".



YOU ARE GOOD TO GO!

All 3rd - 5th students have accessed their Park Tudor Google account at least once this year, with Mrs. Everett. That means most will know their school email address and password, but if you need additional help, email jeverett@parktudor.org.



A word about Chrome: we recommend using it as a browser at home. Chrome remembers accounts, bookmarks and settings, making it easier for students to find their stuff online, at home.
